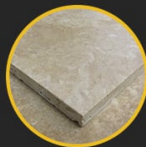


KNOW YOUR NATURAL STONE

Travertine/Limestone



Travertine is a sedimentary rock with a porous composition which is why it requires sealing. Generally travertine has a light beige, cream or ivory colour which makes them popular for bathrooms

Granite is formed from incredibly hot molten lava which makes it an extremely strong natural stone. It features a crystalline structure which provides certain varieties with a unique sparkle

Slate



A much used roof material, slate has a unique riven texture when it is cut, adding character to interior and exterior designs. Its most notable colours are grey, black, green and reddish brown

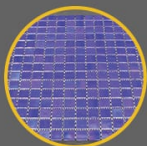
Sandstone
